

Republican Party of Olmsted County Convention Resolutions
For Consideration
Saturday, March 3, 2018

PASSED

1. The Republican Party of Minnesota supports a merit based immigration system.

PASSED

2. Keep voting simple – one person, one vote. Oppose Ranked Choice Voting (Instant Runoff Voting) system in any form. Maintain our primary/runoff voting system to give all voters full participation and maintain the integrity of our voting system.

FAILED

3. BE IT RESOLVED that the Republican Party of Minnesota (1) recognizes pornography as a public health hazard leading to broad spectrum of individual and societal harms; and (2) recognizes the need for education, prevention, research, and policy change at the community and societal level in order to address the pornography epidemic that is harming the people of the State of Minnesota and the nation.

FAILED

4. BE IT RESOLVED by the Republican Party of Minnesota that it should be the policy of the state that every human being has the right to safe, clean, affordable, and accessible water adequate for human consumption, cooking, sanitary purposes, agriculture, recreation and tourism.

FAILED

5. BE IT RESOLVED, the state should prioritize individuals with disabilities and the staff that support them when setting state spending and policy.

FAILED

6. I propose the Republican Party support an amendment to the state Constitution to implement judicial retention elections

FAILED

7. BE IT RESOLVED that the Republican Party of Minnesota supports legislation that continues to reduce the burden of tobacco use on our state, including keeping the prices of tobacco high, increasing tobacco prevention and cessation funding, restricting the sale of flavored and menthol tobacco products, and raising the minimum legal sale age for tobacco products to 21 years.
